Provide health career and wellbeing information and resource stands at your career event or career fair.

Connect you with hospital staff and the latest information and opportunities via the quarterly NHS/DWP focus group and twice yearly vocational learning focus group.

Provide information and sign posting to Cheshire wide volunteering and work experience opportunities in hospitals and other health related organisations.

Connect you with a wide range of hospital and community partners and organisations including partners in social and primary care.

Support mock interview days, assessment and employability days, and health career/wellbeing talks in assemblies.

Provide leaflets, booklets and guides on NHS jobs, job seeker tips, work experience, volunteering, etc.

Provide bespoke career sessions including patient journeys and NHS uniform fashion shows.

Provide interactive workshops/career workshops for primary aged children.

Provide job centre staff and teachers CDP sessions on the wide range of NHS careers, resources and opportunities available.

Sign post to Traineeships, pre-employment programmes, apprenticeships, job vacancies, bank opportunities, hospital events, the Career Hub website and other useful resources.

Invite people to visit the hospital as part of the Insight and Inspire Programme for schools and job seekers.
